



Red Squirrel

*Tamiasciurus hudsonicus*

This feisty and territorial squirrel also enters homes, though not as frequently as Gray or Flying Squirrels. Many of our inspections find Red Squirrels entering under a deck, porch, crawl space or living in the lower levels of a home.

They are very vocal and make a whistling tchrrr sound when alarmed.

They are reddish brown with a white belly, They are 9-11 inches long (including tail) and weigh 7-9 ounces. They feed on Pine seeds, nuts (acorn, hickory black walnut) and berries, bird eggs, insects and bird seed.

Two breeding seasons take place in February and June-July. Litters average 4 per.

Evicting Red Squirrels usually includes pest proofing at the foundation level and excluding areas under a deck or addition.
