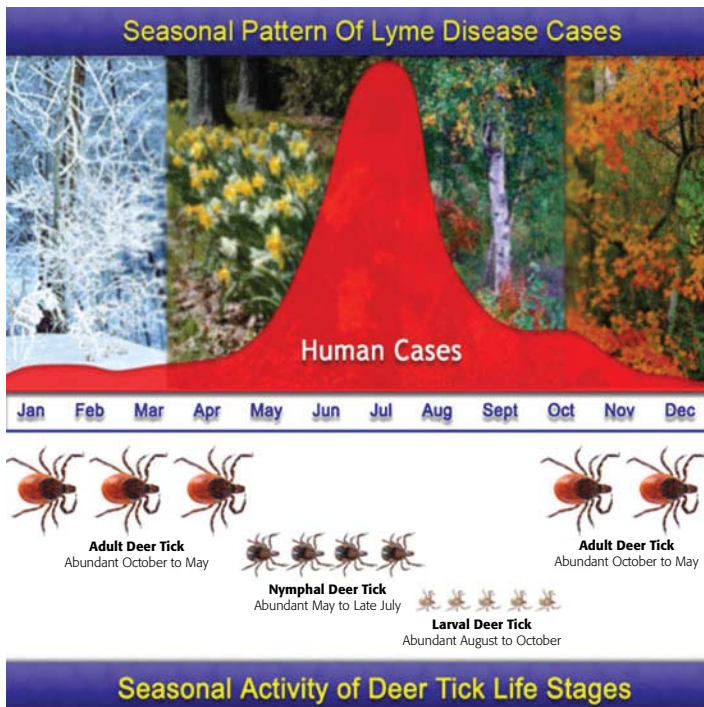

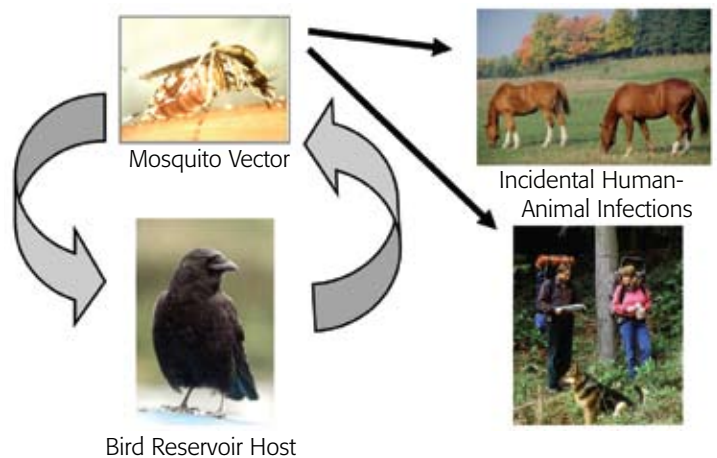

Health Impact From Ticks & Mosquitoes



- The CDC reports that Massachusetts & Rhode Island are the epicenter for tick borne diseases.
- Tick borne diseases can often be debilitating and cost thousands of dollars in health care fees.
- There are over 25,000 new cases of Lyme disease each year in the U.S.
- Studies have shown that 55% of tick populations carry common tick borne disease pathogens.
- CDC is reporting a 40% increase in the U.S. of babe-siosos microti, another tick borne disease.
- The incubation period for Lyme disease may take weeks to several years in humans/pets.



- Mosquitoes are the deadliest animal on the planet, responsible for over 1 million deaths per year around the world.
- Mosquitoes adversely affect our quality of life by limiting our outdoor activities & spreading disease.
- Mosquitoes breed in many standing water areas around your home.
- About 80% of the population is unaware they have contacted a mosquito borne disease until symptoms

- The CDC reports a 30 fold increase in mosquito borne diseases in the last 20 years.



- The mosquito is the only known vector to transmit heartworm to your dog or cat.
- Mosquitoes transmit the serious & potentially fatal heartworm disease to both dogs and cats.
- Heartworm causes long-term poor health in pets: It can last 5-7 years in dogs & 2-3 years in a cat.
- Ticks can transmit debilitating & potentially deadly diseases to your dog or cat.
- It often takes years for lyme disease to be detected in dogs & cats.
- Studies show 15-30% of pets have allergic reactions & infections to mosquito & tick bites.
