



Eastern Gray Squirrel
Sciurus carolinensis

These squirrels have become a major nuisance. Chewing into homes, damaging gutters, fascia and soffits. Destroying personal items in your home. We get them out and repair the areas with a steel mesh.

They are grayish brown with a white belly or black in some areas, They are 17-20 inches long (including tail) and weigh up to 1 ½ pounds. They feed on nuts (acorn, hickory black walnut), seeds and berries, bird eggs and nestlings, insects and bird feeders seed and suet, dig up bulbs, eat garden vegetables and human trash.

Two breeding seasons take place in Spring and late Summer. Litters average 4.

Non-lethal eviction of Gray Squirrels from your home can be accomplished using one way devices and repellants. This must be done during non breeding seasons only! We guarantee all squirrel removal for 12 months.
